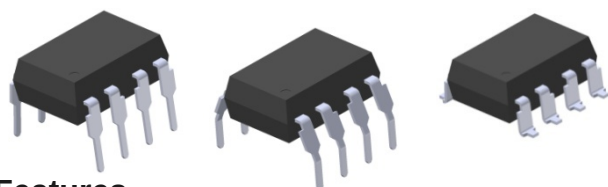


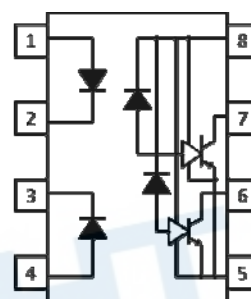

Description

The EL2630 and EL2631 are consists of an infrared emitting diode optically coupled to a high speed integrated photo detector logic gate with a strobable output. It is packaged in a 8-pin DIP package and available in wide-lead spacing and SMD options.

Figure 1. Forward Current vs Forward Voltage

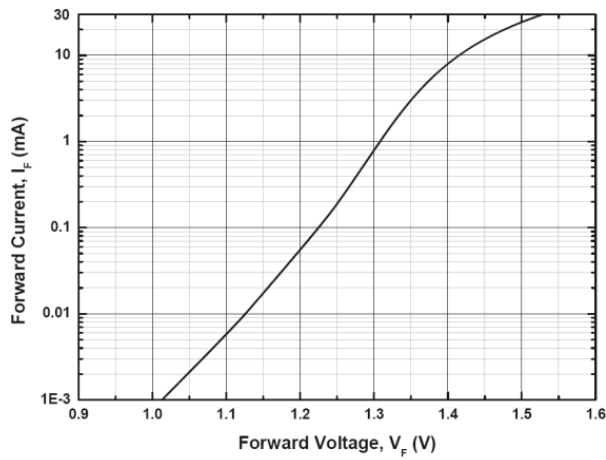


Figure 2. Low Level Output Voltage vs Ambient Temperature

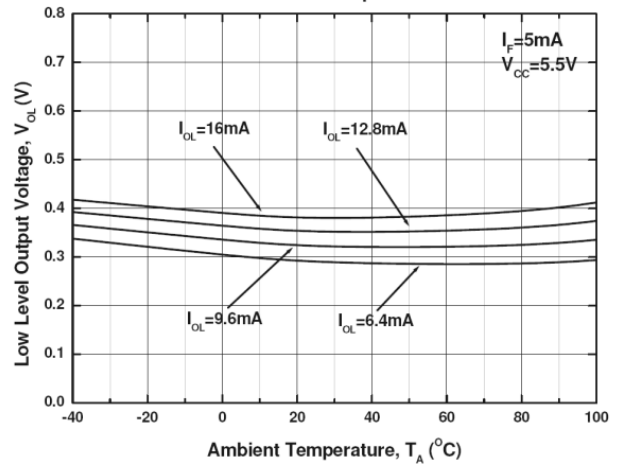


Figure 3. Low Level Output Current vs Ambient Temperature

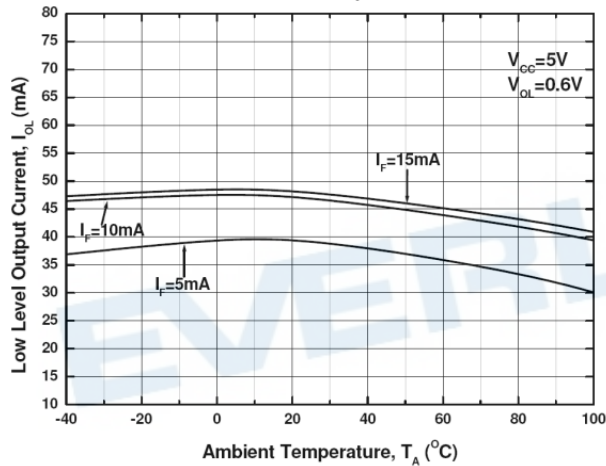


Figure 4. Input Threshold Current vs Ambient Temperature

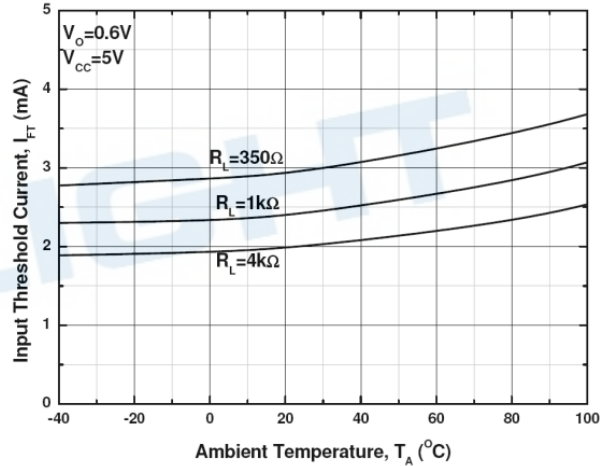


Figure 5. Input Current vs Output Voltage

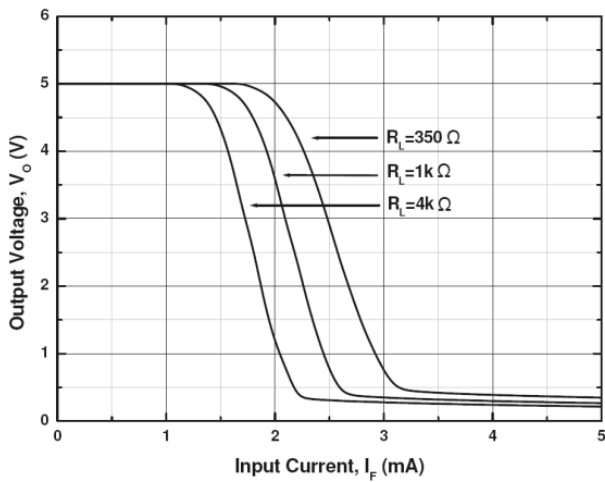


Figure 6. High Level Output Current vs Ambient Temperature

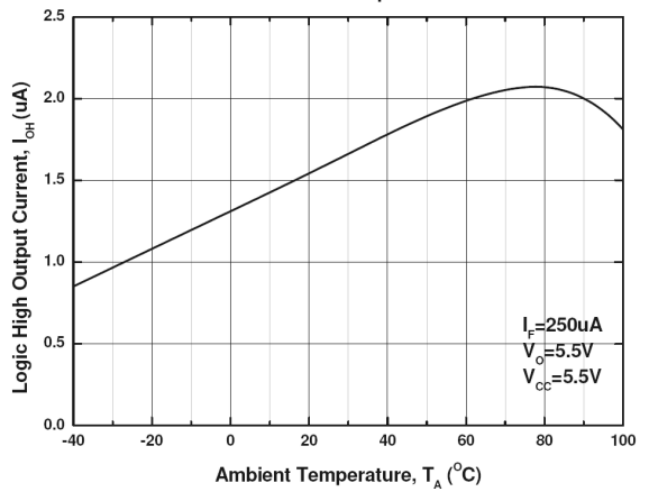


Figure 7. Propagation Delay vs. Forward Current

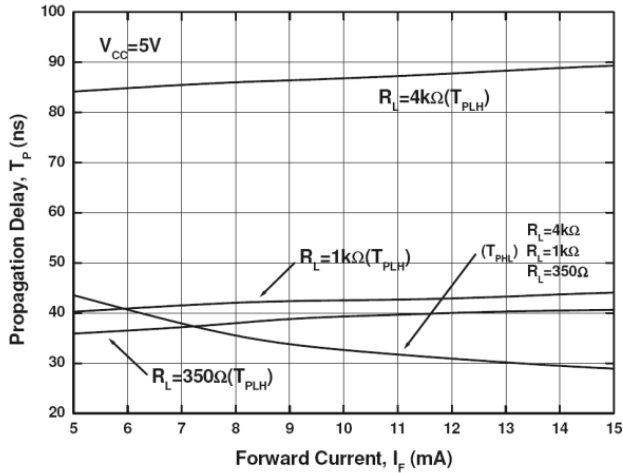


Figure 8. Propagation Delay vs. Temperature

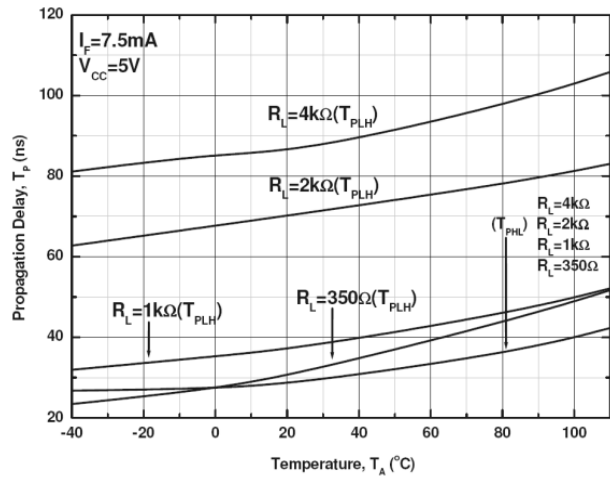


Figure 9. Pulse Width Distortion vs. Temperature

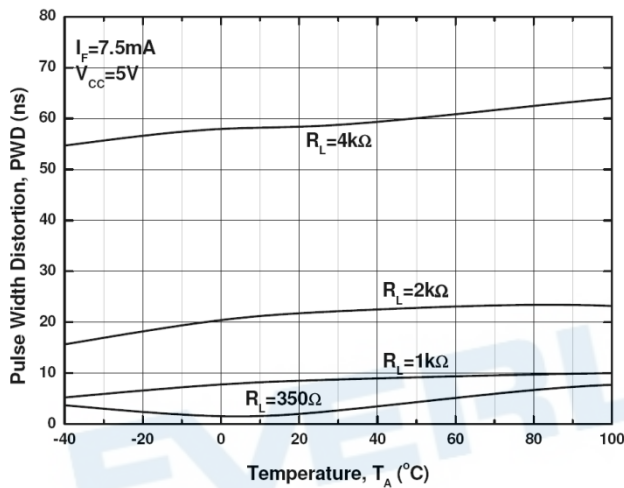


Figure 10. Rise and Fall Time vs. Temperature

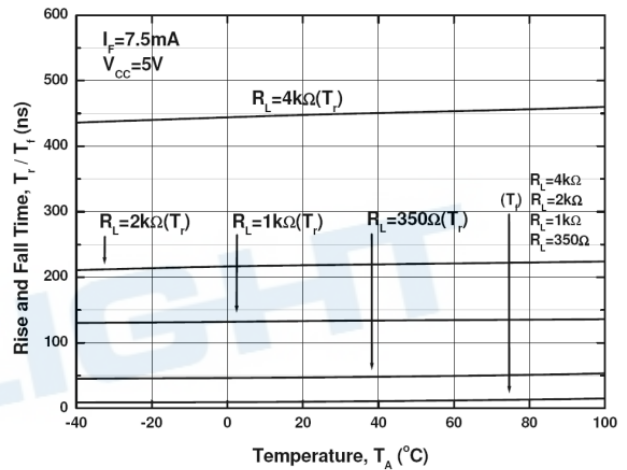


Fig. 11 Test circuit and waveforms for tPHL, tPLH, t_r, and t_f

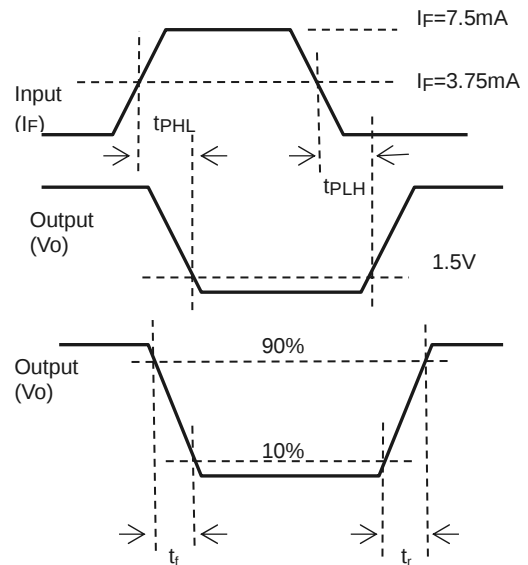
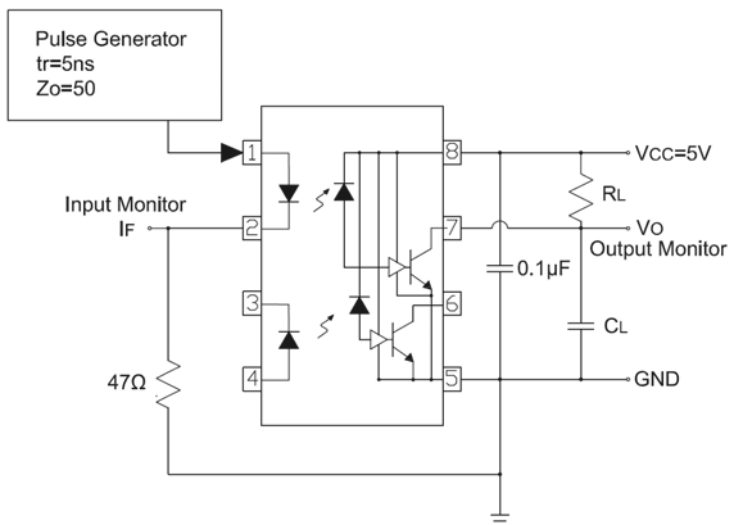
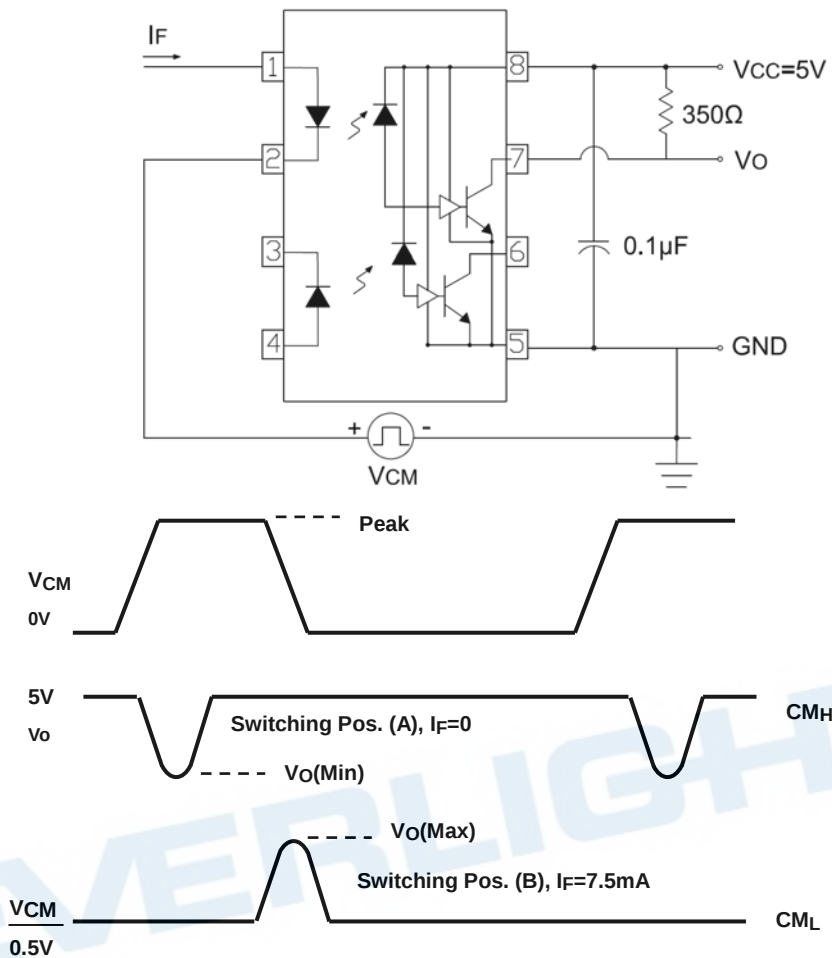


Fig. 12 Test circuit Common mode Transient Immunity



Note

- *3 The V_{CC} supply must be bypassed by a 0.1μF capacitor or larger. This can be either a ceramic or solid tantalum capacitor with good high frequency characteristic and should be connected as close as possible to the package V_{CC} and GND pins
- *4. t_{PLH} – Propagation delay is measured from the 3.75mA level on the HIGH to LOW transition of the input current pulse to the 1.5 V level on the LOW to HIGH transition of the output voltage pulse.
- *5. t_{PHL} – Propagation delay is measured from the 3.75mA level on the LOW to HIGH transition of the input current pulse to the 1.5 V level on the HIGH to LOW transition of the output voltage pulse.
- *6. t_r – Rise time is measured from the 90% to the 10% levels on the LOW to HIGH transition of the output pulse.
- *7. t_f – Fall time is measured from the 10% to the 90% levels on the HIGH to LOW transition of the output pulse.
- *8 CMH– The maximum tolerable rate of rise of the common mode voltage to ensure the output will remain in the HIGH state (i.e., $V_{OUT} > 2.0V$).
- *9 CML– The maximum tolerable rate of rise of the common mode voltage to ensure the output will remain in the LOW output state (i.e., $V_{OUT} < 0.8V$).

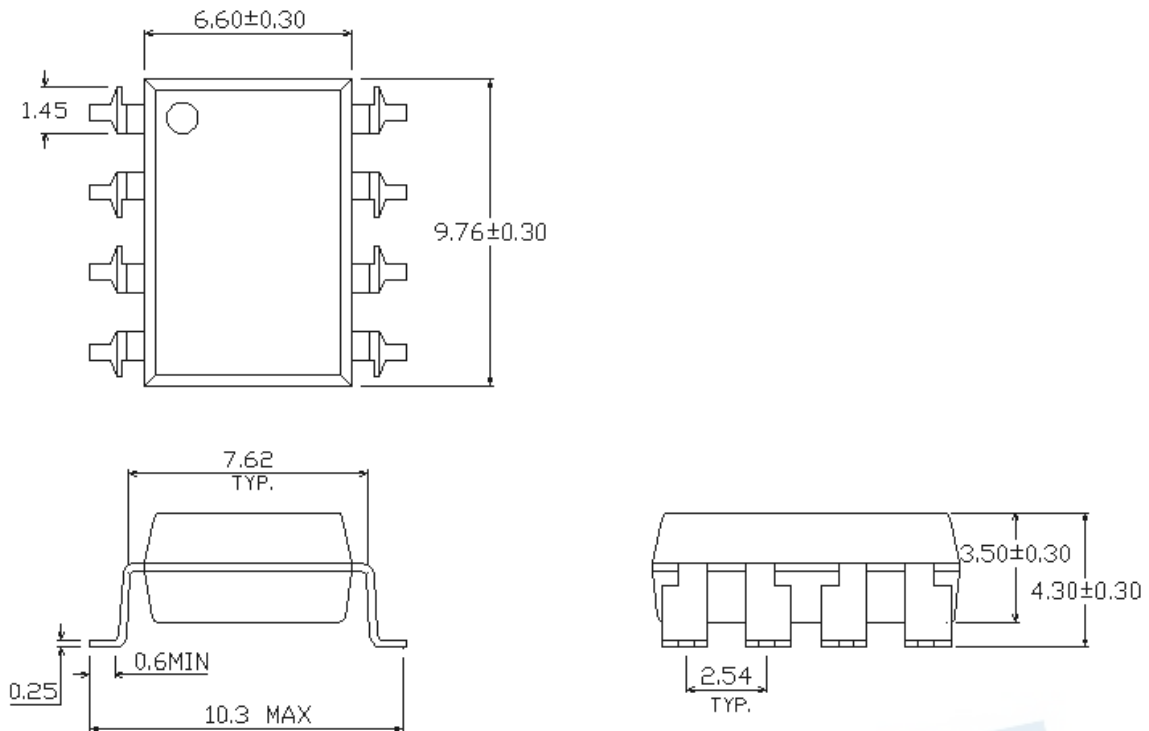

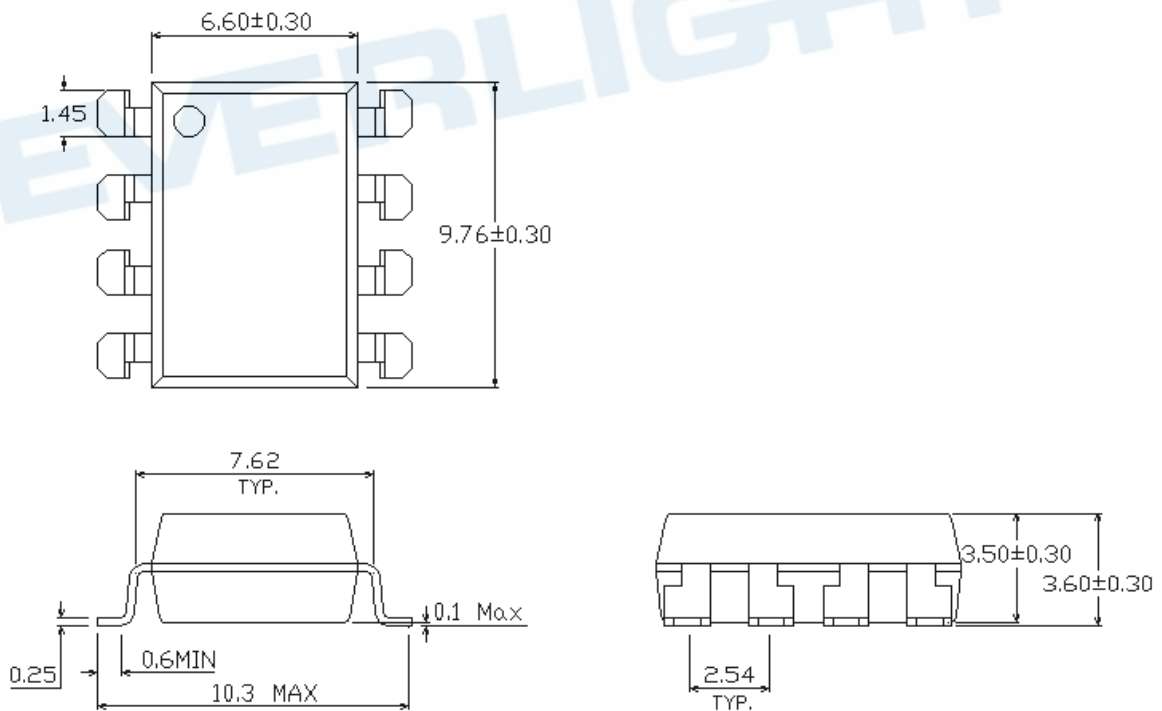

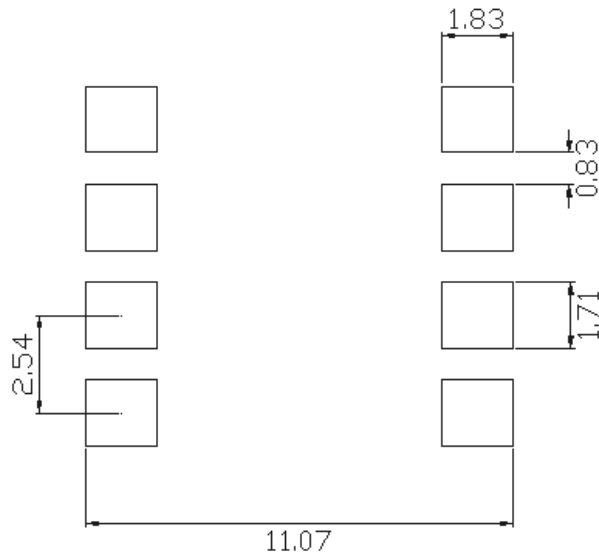

Recommended pad layout for surface mount leadform

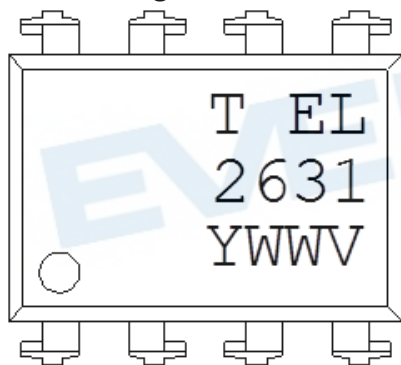

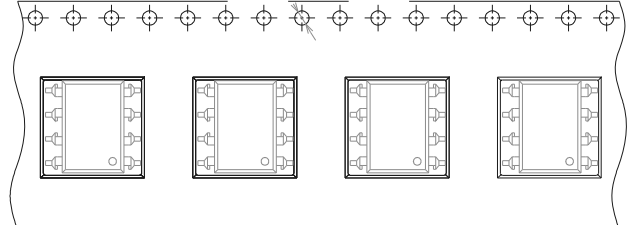

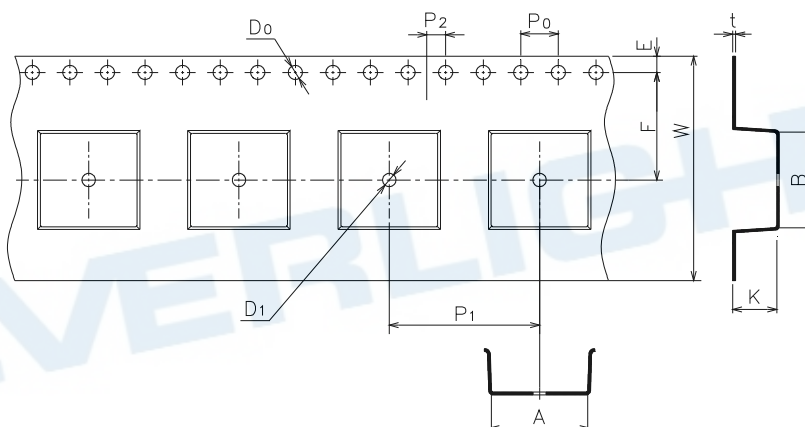
Direction of feed from reel

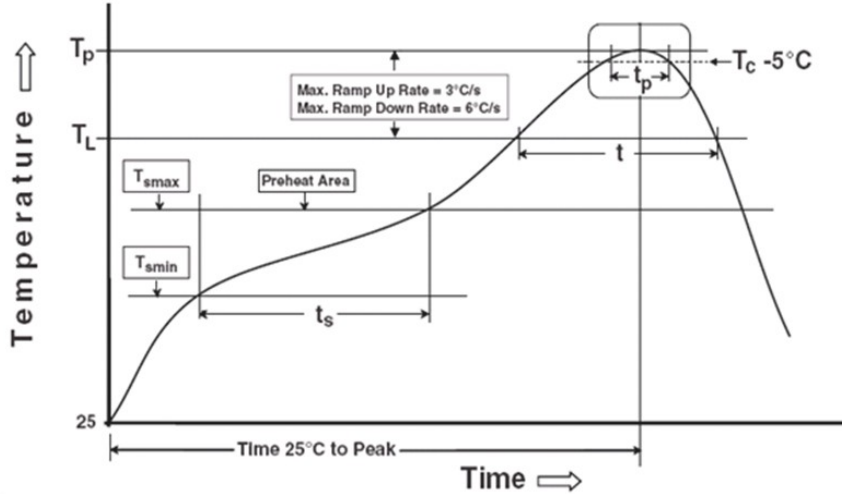
